7th & 8th Grade Parents!

Your student might be eligible to enroll in the Twenty-First Century Scholars program and receive...

Free College Tuition!

If you are an Indiana seventh or eighth grader who qualifies for the program, you can get up to four years of undergraduate college tuition to attend an eligible Indiana public, private or proprietary institution.

You qualify if you:

- Are a resident of Indiana as an applicant and as a scholarship recipient (determined by the residency of your parent or legal guardian)
- Are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen. For more information about citizenship qualifications, check the website.
- Are enrolled in the 7th or 8th grade at an Indiana school recognized by the Indiana Department of Education.
- Fulfill the 21st Century Scholars Pledge.
- Meet eligibility requirements, including placement in foster care, or be a member of a family at or below the current year's income maximums (available on the website).



WHERE CAN I FIND A PROGRAM APPLICATION?

There are worksheets in the North Knox Guidance office. You can turn in the completed application to the Guidance Counselors and they will enroll you in the program if you do not have access to the internet **OR** You can log onto the website and complete the application at home. Applications must be done online.
